## TAXIS

### DOWNTOWN

Downtown-Airport

\$30 – One Person (@\$2.00 for each additional passenger)

### MIDTOWN

Midtown – Airport

\$32 – One Person (@\$2.00 for each additional passenger)

Midtown Flat Rates (fares originating from a business and concluding at a business within the zone)

\$8.00 – one person

\$2.00 – for each additional person

Fared ending outside the zone will be metered. Residential fares within the zone are also metered.

### BUCKHEAD

Buckhead – Airport

\$40 – One Person (@\$2.00 for each additional passenger)

## UBER

Uber seamlessly connects riders to drivers through apps, and helps make Atlanta more accessible. To use Uber, you request a ride via mobile app or the web. Drivers arrive curbside in just minutes, you can track the arrival of your ride, you'll receive a text message when your driver arrives, the credit card on file is charged after your ride, and you will receive an email receipt detailing your trip.

## RENTAL CAR CENTER AT HARTSFIELD-JACKSON ATLANTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

If you choose to rent a car in Atlanta, our rental car center makes it easy once you've arrived at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. The ATL SkyTrain is an elevated train that connects the passenger terminal to the rental car center, and takes customers on a scenic, five-minute ride to the rental car center to sign rental agency contracts and pick up cars. The ATL SkyTrain operates six two-car trains, with each car accommodating up to 50 passengers and their baggage.

The rental car center is a 67.5-acre site across from the airport, and houses all airport rental car companies and their associated operations, including customer service, administrative offices, car pickup and return, fueling and maintenance facilities.

## ATLANTA STREETCAR

The Atlanta Streetcar is the city's newest form of transportation. The electric streetcars operate on rail and offer a safe, convenient means of connecting some of Atlanta's most popular sites. The streetcars make 12 stops along a 2.7-mile. Single trip fare is \$1; multiple trip passes are available.

A fast and affordable way to navigate the city, MARTA is the ninth-largest transit system in the United States, providing approximately 400,000 passenger trips a day in Atlanta. - MARTA's #110 Route, "**The Peach**," connects downtown to Buckhead via Peachtree Street, offering a way to enjoy restaurants, shopping and entertainment along Atlanta's most famous thoroughfare.
